NEW STATE AURORA™ TANKLESS WATER HEATER

ASHLAND CITY, TENN. – August 30, 2004 – The new State Aurora™ Tankless Gas Water Heater is rated to provide a continuous four gallons per minute (GPM) supply of hot water at 77°F rise. The unit is recommended for vacation homes, room additions, and other low-to-medium-demand applications.

The State Aurora tankless water heater is equipped with a copper heat exchanger and operates between 78 and 81 percent efficiency. The tankless design heats water on demand, with inputs modulating from 25,000 to 194,000 BTU, depending on hot water demand. Aurora measures 23.6 inches high, 13.8 inches wide and 9.4 inches deep and is designed for wall-mounted installation with vertical or horizontal power-venting.

An optional remote control is available, which can be installed in the kitchen or another location away from the water heater. The remote control provides digital display of the thermostat setting, push-button temperature adjustment, and an indicator light showing burner operation.
